The Safer Neighbourhood Team at Halesworth continue to support RESPECT ZONE areas outside and close by to primary schools, encouraging safe parking at peak school times. Currently Brampton Primary school is trialling the idea with the next school being Southwold Primary.

Preventing, reducing and solving crime and ASB

SNT continue to work with our partners at Halesworth Town Council and WDC in relation to getting the youth shelter returned to Halesworth Town Park, after reports of anti-social behaviour last year in the area of the shelter and its removal. The shelter should return to the park at a new location in the summer after a lengthy consultation with concerned parties.
