Making the community safer

This month we had a large community engagement event at Bramfield School, particularly engaging with young children giving them a positive experience of meeting the police, often this would be was for the first time in their life. This event was also a great opportunity to speak to local families about the issues that concern them and our team were very pleased to be able to offer advice and guidance on a range of crime reduction matters helping to make families feel safer in their community.

Preventing, reducing and solving crime and ASB

This month saw the start of a new community speedwatch trial at Spexhall that makes innovative use of ANPR camera technology to capture details of vehicles that are regularly breaking the speed limit in the 30 mph zone. Our team then uses the community speedwatch format warning letters to warn the drivers of the offences. Should they persist we can look at visits to help educate the public on the dangers of speeding and the further enforcement penalties that can be imposed on them.
